

Application for the Gaye Ross Scholarship

The Gaye Ross Memorial Nursing Scholarship was established in 1998 by the Registered Nurses working in the Drumheller Health Centre, UNA Local 74. Since the inception of the scholarship in 1998 and up to 2016, 18 students have received \$1,000 annually to support their education to become a Registered Nurse or registered Psychiatric Nurse.

As of April 27, 2016, the scholarship is administrated by the Drumheller Area Health Foundation through an Ad hoc committee and the Education Policy. As of 2018, the scholarship has now been increased to \$1,500 to help our chosen applicant with educational costs.

An Ad hoc Committee shall consist of:

- Chairperson (Exoffico)
- Two Directors at Large of the Drumheller Area Health Foundation
- One Member of the Drumheller Health Centre Management
- One Member of the Nursing Staff of the Drumheller Health Centre
- Two Members of the UNA Local 74 for the selection of the Gaye Ross Nursing Schola

Selection Process

- Candidates must be entering or presently enrolled in a Registered Nurse or Registered Psychiatric Nurse program. Proof of acceptance must be provided.
- Candidates must present, in written form, an explanation on why he/she is deserving of this award and describe their dedication to the nursing profession (maximum 3 pages double spaced).
- Candidates must reside, or have resided, along and/or in the perimeter of the map provided. Included are the communities of Carbon, Chancellor, Craigmyle, Dallum, Delia, Drumheller, East Coulee, Hanna, Hussar, Millerfield, Munson, Morrin, Nacmine, Rockyford, Rosebud, Rowley, Rumsey, Standard, Tolman, and Watts and surrounding areas.
- Applications, including essay, and proof of acceptance must be mailed or emailed to the Drumheller Area Health Foundation by September 1st of each calendar year.
- The Ad hoc Committee will meet and select by September 30th of each calendar year.
- A letter will be sent to each applicant identifying whether they were the successful recipient of the scholarship.
- The scholarship will be presented to the successful recipient in person by members of the Ad hoc Committee.
